It went quite well, with many guests visiting and several returning. As a result of this program, one lady visited for the first time and trusted Christ as her personal Saviour!

The competition was fierce, but there was only one prize! Two of our children were among the top performers, and one actually won! We are thankful for children who are happy to serve in the ministry.

As a result of our visit that day, we were able to acquire some very vital information that has helped us in acquiring necessary information about the property. I am very burdened for his salvation. Please pray that Richard and his father Kingsley will come to know Christ as Saviour and choose to live for Him.
