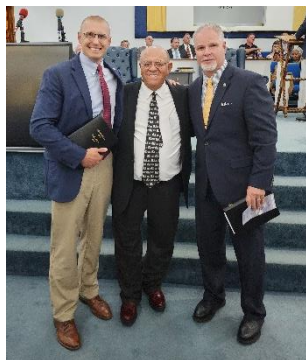


July 2025 Prayer Letter
