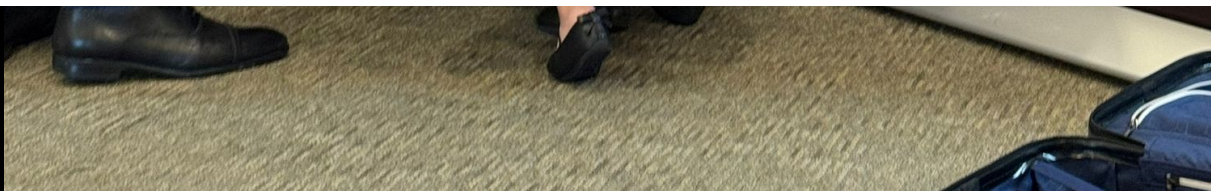

Targeted visits, cultural immersion, and making new contacts in neighborhoods have all been important and exciting opportunities to engage the gospel-needy Rohingya community here in Milwaukee. Pray that strong connections would be made and maintained and that the gospel would break through the stronghold of Islam in the hearts of the Rohingya people.

Major Outreach: January 2026

Earlier this year, in a conversation with the Rohingya Muslim leader in the community center/mosque, I asked him what our home church could do for his community. He stated that we could advocate for his people.

We want to embrace that desire with a loving, gospel centered outreach next January. Early January is when the Rohingya celebrate "Rohingya National Day". We intend to meet the felt need of a stateless, persecuted people by highlighting them and their experience in Milwaukee and across the globe. We will also declare the message of the gospel to meet the deeper spiritual need of the Rohingya and all people.

More details will be forthcoming, but I want to extend an invitation to all of our prayer and financial partners to join us for a Saturday-Sunday outreach in January of 2026. Many of you have expressed interest in coming to help with the work. This would be an ideal opportunity. We will be aggressively inviting the
