Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

Hello again from Madagascar! It is a joy to give you a brief update on our family and ministry again. I would like to share about two specific areas where God has blessed our steps of faith.

When we were building our new church building in 2023, there were so many decisions to make. It was my first building project, and many of the decisions wore me out mentally. The biggest decision was the size of the building. I can remember asking myself, "Is this too big? Will we ever fill this up?" We were not only in a building project, but also getting ready to send out three men to start churches. By faith, we built a building where we could double in attendance. By faith, we recently purchased over 20 pews to completely fill out the main floor and give us a main floor seating capacity of 225. Last Sunday, we had a special Sunday and invited many people. God gave us 19 visitors, 204 in attendance, and two saved! As we continue to focus on doing our part to fulfill the Great Commission, we trust the Lord to give us souls saved, baptized and added to the church!

Another step of faith we took last October was starting a Faith Promise Missions program. I did not know how this would go because of the extreme poverty here. I had several worries for sure. So far, our people have given around \$500 every month to missions! This month, in addition to helping our church planters out of our own church, we sent money to help three African church planters in Uganda out of Missionary Matt Stensaas' ministry. This is also fruit to your account!
