Boozhoo (Ojibwe for "Hello"),

Thank you for praying for our evangelistic outreaches this July! We have been busy reaching out in the White Earth community as much as possible during these active summer months. Pray for us to make fruitful contacts.

Basketball Outreach

A church from Kansas that connected with us this past Spring came up to help us do an outreach called Good News Hoops on July 18th. They were able to help pass out gospel tracts with the basketball tournament invites in the towns of White Earth, Ogema, and Waubun. The day of the basketball outreach there was a good chance of rain that concerned us. The Lord held off the rain long enough for us to play some basketball on the courts just north of our church building and take time to preach the gospel to seventeen teenagers! This was no doubt the first time many of them had ever heard the truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Once the rain did come, one of the attendees suggested we move the tournament to the community center. This enriched our contact with the community in many ways and several parents were greatly appreciative of what we were doing for their young people. We have scheduled to do this outreach again next year with the anticipation of building upon what took place this year.

Vacation Bible School

We also just finished up a great week of Vacation Bible School July 28-30. We are thankful for Evangelist Duane Moore and a church from Georgia taking time to come all the way up to Northwest Minnesota to help us. Our theme was "Jesus is Our True North".
